

Workshop Description and Schedule Overview

5-day Intensive Training Workshop

Demonstrations, lecture, discussion, exercises are combined to provide participants with a working model of the comprehensive clinical framework involved in a strategic Ericksonian approach. The workshop concentrates on diagnosis and treatment planning and the use of carefully planned therapeutic metaphors and assignments. It is organized around the content of Carol's books, *The Answer Within* and *Tales of Enchantment*. The workshop emphasizes the concepts and misconceptions of hypnosis, induction techniques, uses and contraindications of hypnosis. Clinical frameworks will continually be emphasized while technical components are taught. These include indirect suggestion, metaphor construction formulas, multiple embedded metaphor, ambiguous function assignments, paradoxical and skill building assignments.

- Day 1: Epistemology & Hypnotic Induction
- Day 2: Indirect Suggestion & Diagnostic Assessment
- Day 3: Affect Metaphors and Attitude Metaphors Protocol
- Day 4: Behavior Metaphors and Self Image Thinking
- Day 5: Multiple Embedded Metaphor and Assignments

Learning Objectives

- 1.To understand concepts and misconceptions of hypnosis.
- 2. To be able to construct therapeutic metaphors designed for affect retrieval, attitude change, and behavior illustration.
- 3. To be able to use ten categories of indirect suggestion.
- 4. To be able to use three types of assignment: paradoxical, skill building, and ambiguous function.
- 5. To create therapeutic contracts related to hypnotherapy.

3-Day Advanced Training Workshop

Specific techniques and procedures for this workshop include strategic use of trance phenomena for pain-control; therapeutic strategies for trauma resolution; and developing an experiential framework to facilitate mind body spirit wellness and personal development through hypnotic work.


