

Workshop Descriptions and Learning Objectives

10 Hour Introduction to Hypnosis

Description: Demonstrations, lecture, and exercises are combined to provide participants with a working knowledge of a strategic Ericksonian approach that supports a natural use of hypnosis. The workshop includes an emphasis on interpersonal diagnosis that results in a treatment plan of desired experiences and contexts in which they are needed. It is organized around the content of Carol's book, *The Answer Within: A Clinical Framework of Ericksonian Hypnotherapy*. Carol will describe the concepts and misconceptions of hypnosis, induction techniques, uses and contraindications of hypnosis. Clinical frameworks will continually be emphasized while technical components are taught. These include the Conscious/Unconscious induction sequence steps and ten categories of indirect suggestion and therapeutic binds.

Learning Objectives:

1. To become familiar with Ericksonian worldview to utilize everything a client brings.
 2. To be able to direct several types of formal hypnotic inductions.
 3. To learn the Conscious/Unconscious dissociation induction sequence.
 4. To be able to recognize and use ten categories of indirect suggestion.

40 Hour Ericksonian Hypnotherapy Applications

Description: In this 5 day workshop participants will learn the comprehensive clinical framework of a strategic Ericksonian approach featuring utilization, interpersonal diagnosis, treatment planning with identification of specific affect, attitude, and behavior goals. Protocols will be taught for creating metaphors specific to each type of goal and these will be organized in a multiple embedded metaphor framework. Therapeutic metaphors are supported with indirect suggestion as a modality for communication to retrieve experiential resources in hypnotherapy. Carol's book, *Tales of Enchantment*, categorizes therapeutic goals of retrieving affect, challenging limiting beliefs, and illustrating desired behavior. Therapists learn to help clients create an associative link such that beneficial emotions, solution supporting attitudes, and novel behaviors become available to them in the context where they are needed. Carol will teach a method to facilitate mental rehearsal of upcoming situations that incorporates these resource experiences through self image thinking. Three types of therapeutic assignments will be presented and practiced: paradoxical, skill building, and ambiguous function. Ten categories of trance phenomena will be taught and applications made for the strategic use of these phenomena for pain management and trauma resolution.

Learning Objectives:

1. To be able to create metaphors for affect retrieval, attitude change, and behavior illustration.
 2. To be able to use indirect suggestion in stories to punctuate relevant personal experience.
 3. To be able to use three types of assignment: paradoxical, skill building, ambiguous function.
 4. To be able to strategically direct the use of trance phenomena for pain management.
 5. To be able to facilitate dissociative review for reinterpreting and resolving trauma.



Working knowledge of hypnotic induction is a prerequisite for the Hypnotherapy Applications Intensive. This working knowledge can be acquired in the 10 Hour Introduction to Hypnosis immediately preceding the 5 day intensive.
